



Non-chronological reports about the weather and its effects.</p>  <p>Fiction: Narrative using the text 'Lila and the Secret of Rain'.</p> 	<p>The Water Cycle</p>  <p>We will begin a yearlong study of trees and how they change through the seasons.</p> 	<p><u>Number</u> Counts in steps of 2s, 3s and 5s, from 0 and steps of 10 from any number, forward and backward Recalls and uses number +/- facts to 20 Adds and subtracts mentally and with objects one- and two-digit numbers Knows the 2x, 5x and 10x tables, including recognising odd and even numbers Recognises, finds, names and writes 1/3, 1/4, 1/2 and 3/4 of size, shape or quantity Writes simple fraction facts, e.g. 1/2 of 6 = 3</p> <p><u>Measurement</u> Combines amounts of money to make a value, Tells the time to the nearest 5 minutes, including drawing clocks</p> <p><u>Geometry</u> Describes properties of 2D shapes, including number of sides and symmetry Describes properties of 3D shapes, including number of edges, vertices and faces</p> <p><u>Statistics</u> Interprets and constructs simple tables, tally charts and pictograms</p>
