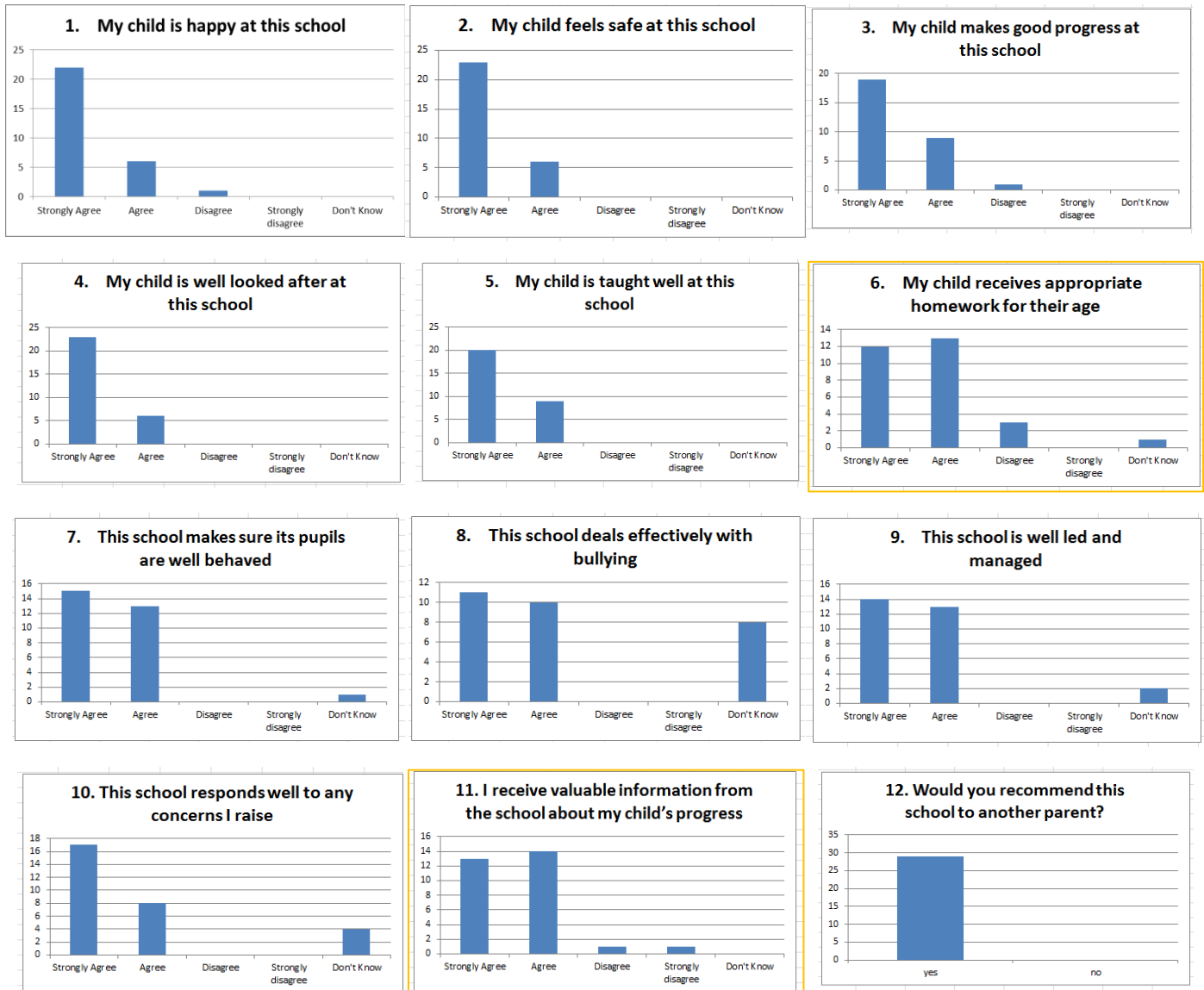
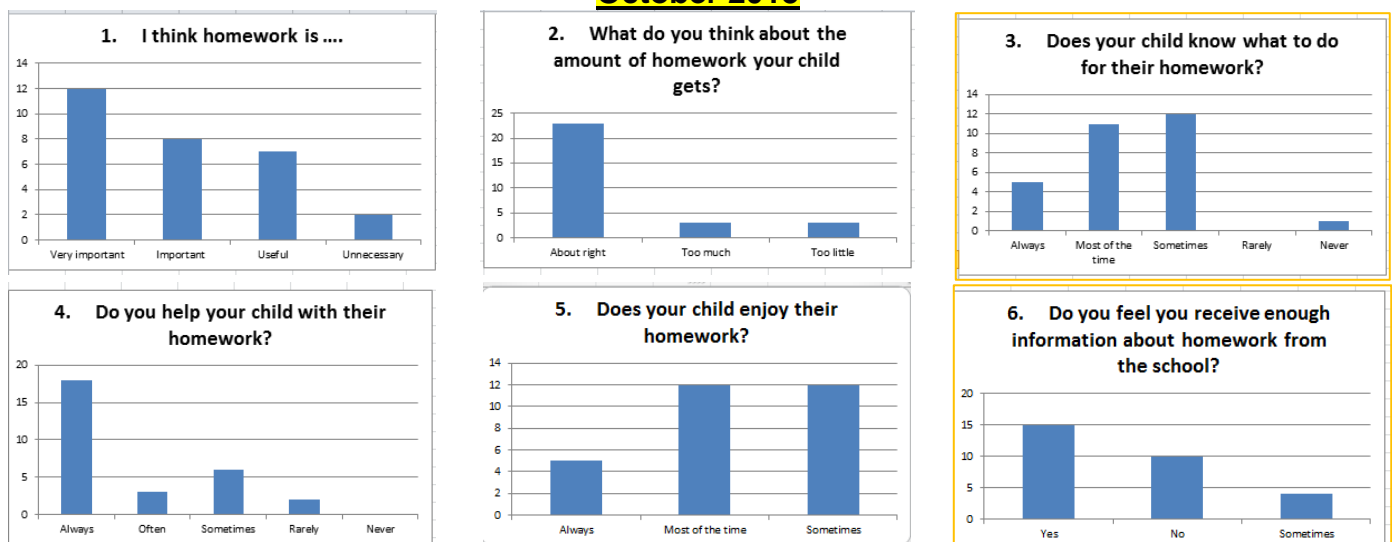


Parent View Questionnaire December 2015

In response to these questionnaires, we would like to begin addressing some of the weaker responses in the following ways:

- Teachers have begun to consider how our homework system can be made simpler and clearer for both parents/carers and for children.
- We have produced a booklet that explains the changes to how children are assessed. Parent/carers are invited to an informal coffee/tea drop-in meeting on **Thursday 21st January at 2.30pm or at 6pm** (please return the reply slip to the office), where the changes can be discussed further and any questions answered.
- At the next parents' evening, the progress of children within the new assessment system will be discussed with you so that it is clear how your child is doing in their learning and what their next steps should be
- Initially, teachers will explore questions 8 and 12 (in particular) further with their classes, as well as some specific questions that need unpicking for their own classes. Pupil voice will begin looking closely at the responses and discussing ways forward. More information will follow soon.
