Year Three and Four Relationships and Sex Education

In Term Six, Year Three and Year Four will be learning about a 'Changing Me'. We will be teaching the same content as previous years, as reflected by the School's Policy, but after much research we have decided to use different, more up to date resources, which are part of our whole school PSHE curriculum.

In Year Three the children will be learning to:

- Recognise the physical differences between girls and boys and use the correct names for parts of the body.
- Know that some parts of the body are private.
- Understand that in animals and humans lots of changes happen between conception and growing up.
- Understand how babies grow and develop in the mother's uterus and understand what a baby needs to live and grow.

Reference will be made to the fact that it takes a man and a woman to make a baby. They will NOT be taught how this happens!

In Year Four the children will be learning to:

• Understand and identify how boys' and girls' bodies need to change so that when they grow up their bodies can make babies.
