Claim your free school meals

All children up to the age of seven at state-funded schools now get free hot meals every day.

Anyone with a child in Reception, Year One or Year Two and thinks they would have been entitled to claim free school meals should still apply because funding is granted to schools based on the number of pupils entitled to receive this benefit.

It is important that parents with children in Key Stage Two should still apply too. For every pupil entitled to claim free school meals, the school will receive £1,300. This money is called Pupil Premium and is used to support children's learning. For each eligible child, the school receives funding for the next six years, even if their parents go back to full time paid work. Details of how to apply can be found
