Fire Evacuation

Thank you for your support for our fire evacuation last week. Everything went according to plan. We will be carrying out another unannounced test at this time in the future so please familiarise yourself with the arrangements. We would like to remind everyone that if you hear the fire bell on the approach to school please do not enter the building or site.

Safeguarding

For safeguarding reasons, it is requested that you do not leave your child alone outside of, or indeed on, the school premises unless they are in the confines of the breakfast club or school building during the permitted times. Breakfast club staff will be onsite from 7.45am. Some Key Stage Two children have been arriving before this time and have been waiting outside unsupervised. As you can appreciate this is a particularly vulnerable time as there are few adults onsite and those that are, are not responsible for supervising unattended children.

In Key Stage One, we are encouraging the children to become more independent when entering the classes in the morning. However we ask parents not to drop these young children at the school gates but to accompany them to the classrooms.

Safeguarding Training Update

All staff have undertaken general awareness training around the Government's Prevent Duty. Prevent is a government strategy designed to stop people becoming terrorists or supporting terrorist or extremist causes. The Prevent strategy covers all types of terrorism and extremism, including political and religious extremism. Find attached a guidance leaflet which helps parents/carers to understand what the Prevent Duty is about. If you have any questions, feel free to come and speak to me.

Parking

Please do not park across our neighbours driveways. Our neighbours need access to their properties at all times. Please be considerate in all the surrounding roads.

Also please do not use the school car park unless you are a blue badge holder or collecting an ill child. Please communicate this to anyone who may drop off or collect your children.
