All adults on the school site (staff, parents/carers, governors, visitors) will no longer be permitted to take mobile phones into classrooms etc. There are lockers provided so that they can be used to lock phones away. When parents/carers volunteer to help on school trips, mobile phones will no longer be permitted to be taken as a school mobile phone will be taken for emergencies or contact with school.
