

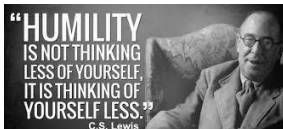

Attendance

We have updated our attendance policy (see school website) and would like to remind parents/carers of the importance around regular attendance.

Poor attendance can seriously affect each child's:

- attainment in school
- relationships with other children and their ability to form lasting friendships
- confidence to attempt new work and work alongside others

In summary:

96%+ Excellent	Well done! This will help all aspects of their progress and life in school. This will give them a good start in life and supports a positive work ethic.
94-95% Average	Well done, strive to build on this.
85-93% Poor	Absence is now affecting attainment and progress at school. Please work with the school urgently to improve the situation.
Below 85% Unacceptable	Absence IS causing SERIOUS CONCERN. It IS affecting attainment and progress and is disrupting your child's learning. We will work with you and the Education Welfare Officer [EWO] to improve your child's attendance.

Children are able to come into class from 8.40am but **should be in school no later than 8.50am**. Please note that morning registration **ends at 8.55am** and children arriving **after 8.55am** must come to the office and sign in the late book. School gates will be closed at 8.55am with access to the school through the main school gates only. Thank you for your cooperation.
