## Welcome Back!

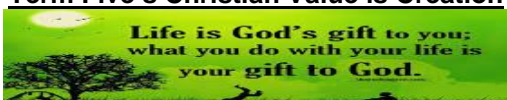
My goodness, who can believe that we are in Term Five already! I hope that you have all had a wonderful Easter break with your families.
