After School Fire Evacuation

We will be having an after-school fire evacuation before the end of Term Five. This will be as children are being dismissed from their classrooms and children and parents/carers are leaving the premises. If you are approaching school and hear the fire alarm please do not enter the building. If your child is with you they will remain in your care and you must assemble at the nearest Fire Evacuation Assembly Point. These are located by the bike shed, or near the approach to the exit at Monks Hill (look for the green assembly point signs like the one above on the fence.) If you are near the main gates please go to the assembly point by the white wall. If your child is still with their teacher they will evacuate the classroom to their line-up point in the playground.

As this is the first time we have had an evacuation at this time we are advising you of the procedures to follow.
