Supporting and Challenging Our Children's Behaviour As we are all aware the behaviour of our

children is usually exceptional and so to continue with our high expectations of behaviour, each class will be revisiting the behaviour policy within their learning this week. Classes will create class contracts and the expected behaviours will be discussed and reinforced. As a school we will be using the language of 'expected and unexpected' behaviours to describe children's choices and actions. We will be continuing to reward children using the school systems of specific praise, stickers, house points and purple cards. We would like to introduce an Outstanding Achievement Award which some children will be nominated for at the end of a term by their class teachers and / or peers. Our Red Card system still remains however unexpected behaviour choices will result in children spending some time reflecting on their choices during some of their playtime or lunchtime. Rest assured children will have been given ample opportunity to reflect on their behaviour choices before they receive a sanction and parents/carers will be kept informed. The updated
