Home-School Communication Books

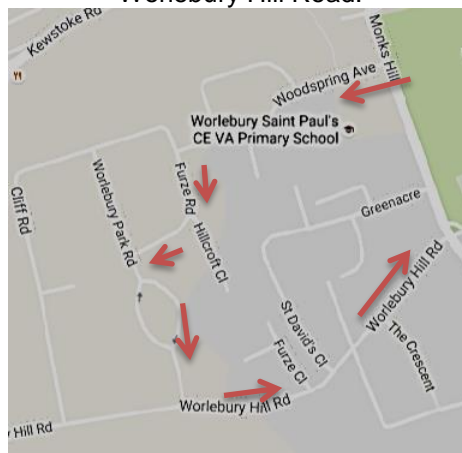
Please remember to write in your child's Home-School Communication books if there are any messages for your child's teacher, especially if they are going home with someone different.

Free School Meals (FSM)

Free School Meals (Pupil Premium entitlement) is separate to the universal free school meals that all Reception, Year One and Year Two children get. For every child that is entitled to this pupil premium, the school receives a small amount of extra funding from the Government. There may be children who are entitled to FSMs but whose parents have not yet claimed them, particularly in Reception, Year One and Year Two as we have no FSM children in these year groups currently (this is quite unusual). Even if your child will not be having school dinners please fill in the relevant paperwork and claim the funding as the extra money that the school receives helps us to improve the provision for all the children's learning, including the child who is in receipt of that funding. Forms are available on the North Somerset Council website or from the school office.

One-way System

To try and alleviate some of the traffic congestion around the entrance to the school and on Woodspring Avenue before and after school, could we please use a one-way system. If cars enter onto Woodspring Avenue to drop off children at school, then please could you continue around and exit via Worlebury Hill Road.
